Motion To Extend Time for Filing Appellant Reply Brief

TO THE HONORABLE COURT OF APPEALS:

Pursuant to Rules 10.5(b) and 38.6(d) of the Texas Rules of Appellate Procedure, The Appellant, Ronald F. Avery, moves this Court for a ten (10) day extension of time to file his Appellant's Reply Brief, and respectfully submits the following:

The deadline for filing the Appellant's Reply Brief:

The deadline for filing the Appellant's Reply brief is February 1, 2017.

The Length of the Extension Sought:

The Appellant seeks a ten (10) day extension until February 13, 2017.

Number of Extensions in this Matter:

The Appellee, Guadalupe County Appraisal District, has moved for and obtained an unopposed 30 day extension to file their Appellee Brief.

Facts In Support of this Motion to Extend Time To File Reply Brief:

1. Since January 27, The Appellant has been reeling under the shock of the denial of a Motion for Rehearing in the Supreme Court of Texas in his Avery v. Baddour; Hearst libel case. This denial has entrapped him under the so-called "Texas Citizens Participation Act" and arbitrary rulings of judges that eradicated his statutory-matter-of-law evidence of defamation and the omnipotent making of lies into truth by judges.
