RE: Special Session: The connection between "Property Tax Reform," "Anti-Israel Policies are Anti-Texas Policies," "Calling for a Convention of States to rein in an out of control federal government."

Dear Governor Abbott,

I have been watching the efforts of Senator Brandon Creighton and others in their attempt to reform the "ever increasing ad valorem property tax problem." And I saw that he requested a Special Session of the Legislature to address that problem. I also received word from you today that you are indeed calling a Special Session to deal with "Property Tax Reform" and other problems.

But I am very skeptical that anything meaningful will come from such noise we have all heard over and over for many years regarding "Property Tax Reform." I have discovered that the United States of America was created for only two purposes and that was to establish religious freedom and prevent the feudal system. I also have discovered that "ad valorem property tax" is the feudal system. It is confiscation of the property of the people without compensation and charging them an eternal rent to possess. If they fail to pay their feudal rents they will be evicted by the "State of Texas" and the property leased to another more healthy tenant who is willing to feed the appetites of the people created by the mass media, education and government. A boycott of a person today who holds the truth and expresses it can drive him off his own property which was the condition of the feudal life in the dark ages.

But we in America hold our property with an allodial title not a feudal title as Thomas Jefferson makes so clear in his *A Summary View of the Rights of British America* he published in 1774. The property of the citizens of Texas cannot be alienated by their government, or any other, for the payment of taxes, fees, money or performance of anything else for the payment of debt or any other purpose. Jefferson also said that the Saxons in England owned their property in that fashion and that is the basis of the common law in America that should have been adopted and instituted by every state constitution.

John Adams said in his *Dissertation on the Canon and Feudal Law* published in 1768 that the canon and feudal law were the worst systems of tyranny ever developed by mankind.

Now this talk of "property tax reform" is simply a con job put over on the people who don't know any better. Property tax should not exist in Texas or any other state of the union. And why do we have it? We have it because the bankers want it. They got rid of statewide property taxes because when they climbed too high the whole state would rise up in unison. The banks conceived of thousands of separate state government entities that could impose property tax for the payment of bank debts that would actually compete with one another for the better looking communities. The people cannot unify under this system and they knew it.

These 11 bank conglomerates that issue debt for all states of the union do so with guaranteed payment secured by the police arm of the state. If a few knowledgeable souls can't conform enough to pay the rent to retire the debt, they lose their property and a compliant tenant will take over the state rent payments and use the property. The banks no longer operate in the free market. They operate in the police market. They don't take risks and consider new ideas or needs of the average person when they simply can create the desire in a community to look better than their neighboring community with finer buildings and facilities. What about the big companies? They get "property tax waivers" so they don't have to pay those high property taxes to get those fine things because the community benefits so much from their partnership.

Why are the people not aware of this to stop it? The purpose of "free public education" under Article 7 Section 1 is to teach the student how to defend their life, liberty and property. But no teacher dare tell them they and their parents lost their property to pay for their education. And the sole purpose of lawful government is to protect the life, liberty and possessions of each citizen yet we lost our property in the process of paying for its protection. This is the greatest absurdity in the world according to Samuel Adams who said "If men, through fear, fraud, or mistake, should in terms renounce or give up any essential natural right, the eternal law of reason and the grand end of society would absolutely vacate such renunciation. The right to freedom being the gift of God Almighty, it is not in the power of man to alienate this gift and voluntarily become a slave." We obviously live in this absurdity in Texas today and few have a clue about it. They hurt, but they don't even know if they should hurt, or not.

Why all this concern over a "Convention of the States to rein in an out of control federal government," when clearly the "State of Texas" has destroyed the entire Article 1 Bill of Rights with its claim of "sovereign immunity" to harm the citizen and their property, even unto death, without judicial recourse, unless waived by statute or congressional resolution prior to suit, like a mad king. When challenged, the Supreme Court of Texas can base it only on **an erroneous presumption of what the common law was prior to the constitution** (<http://www.postwtc.com/pet-f-rev-toc.html>). But we don't like the federal government telling us what to do in violation of the U.S. Constitution. The feds are supposed to guarantee every state a republican form of government where each state determines their own laws except in areas of national defense, international trade and treaties, interstate trade, and individual rights that should be protected in every state. The feds mandate programs for the states then expect the states to pay for them.

They take over state property for functions they have no right to perform. The feds have instituted unconstitutional programs like the federal reserve that is nothing more than a private banking cartel that loans credit to the government with paper debt notes that are unlawful and unconstitutional and force every state in the union to use. The feds fund and maintain a continual standing army without a declaration of war for more than two years in violation of the U.S. Constitution.

How is it that a member of the Israeli Knesset can walk the halls of the Texas State Capitol like they are a legislator and hang out with all the representatives and create legislation in Texas while there are no Palestinian leaders allowed on a plane much less the capitol? How can Israel get away with all kinds of crimes against humanity and when Christian churches in America attempt to sanction them as the federal government does to many nations, Texas prevents it with laws?

All this comes from the same source: our feudal slavery to pay debts to a handful of banks; our fraudulent unconstitutional currency controlled by a private banking cartel; our unlawful federal military funded and operating for over 70 years without a declaration of war; the refusal of the federal government to investigate 9/11/01 and the evidence that has been uncovered by engineers and scientists that prove the official story to be a lie; a cancerous and inoperable unlawful union with Israel. None of these problems will be solved, and they will only get worse, until the people learn what their true inheritance is, and those in high places decide they will no longer serve the interest of tyrants and criminal bankers who have stolen the wealth and property of the American people.

I have brought this matter of unlawful feudal property taxation to the attention of the courts of Texas and the 4th Court of Appeals could only respond that it is **presumed to be part of the common law present prior to the Texas Constitution of 1876**. I proved that to be error with superior unchallenged authority of the founders' own writings. I filed my Petition for Review in the Supreme Court of Texas on 5/31/17 in my Property Tax Protest case against Guadalupe County Appraisal District: <http://sueit.org/avgcad-petition-for-review-w-appendix.pdf> All I have said regarding property tax herein is proven in that document and no one has shown otherwise by superior evidence. It is time to correct this error for the life, liberty and possessions of the people of Texas.

I hereby request that you present this matter of unlawful feudal "ad valorem property tax" to the Texas Congress and ask that property taxation be continued only until the present debt is paid off and that no new property taxes be imposed immediately for any new debt. **Let's stop false presumptions about the applicable law in Texas** and Let us stop the tyranny in Texas so that we may see clearly how to stop the tyranny in Washington D.C.
