I just want to add that public education is a state function and duty and not a duty of the local areas under Art. 7 Sec. 1 and that under the same provision public school is to be free and that does not mean aliening the property of those in a district and forcing them to pay for the construction of schools or be evicted from their homes and businesses. Under the same provision the purpose of public free schools is to teach the people how to defend their property consisting of life, liberty and possessions. So how can the students learn this when they and their parents lose their property to pay for it? It must stop.

Property tax is unlawful in every state of the Union

Thomas Jefferson said that our Saxon forefathers owned their property in absolute dominion with an allodial title disencumbered with feudal duties and that is to be the basis of the common law in the United States of America. Therefore, your property is not alienable for taxation.

John Adams said that the United States was settled and designed for two things: Establishment of Religious Freedom against the Canon Law, which he called Ecclesiastical tyranny; and Protection of property title against the Feudal Law which he called Civil Tyranny.

John Locke said that men do not have authority to give up their own property or to take the property of others and therefore cannot delegate such an authority to the state at its creation or for its support. No one can delegate to another more than they hold in themselves.

Samuel Adams said it is the greatest absurdity to suppose it in the power of men to give up their right of life, liberty and property ownership to create & support government for its purpose is to protect those very things. If they do renounce those rights such renunciation must be vacated.

The Texas Supreme Court says just the opposite: They say authority to alien property for taxation was adopted into the Texas Constitution of 1876 from pre-existing common law and that men have authority to take the property of others and can delegate that to government and they can give up their natural rights and become tenants, serfs and slaves. Which of these two groups has the most authority to speak about how we should own property in every state of the Union? Shall we own it like royalty or rent it from the state as serfs?

Texas Representatives & Senators:

I want all my representatives (and Senators) to know that "property taxes" are unlawful in every state of the Union according to Thomas Jefferson who said that we own property in America with a superior unencumbered allodial title that cannot be aliened for the performance of anything including the payment of "taxes" or rents or any other feudal duties for the creation or support of government. John Adams called property taxation civil tyranny and said that America was built for only two reasons; to secure religious freedom and to prevent the feudal system. The state of Texas nor any of its subdivisions can obtain lawful authority to impose "property tax" or any other feudal system on the people of Texas. There is no justification for them.

The state has only two sources of authority to do anything and both deny it authority to alien property for the creation or support of the state; adoption of pre-existing applicable common law under Art. 16 Sec. 48 and direct delegation in the Constitution under Art. 1 Sec. 2.

As I have shown above and below, the applicable common law in America is that we own property as our Saxon forefathers with an unalienable allodial title like royalty. The only exception to that is

where it can be shown that William the Norman or any of his successors have conquered the subject property. This cannot be shown for any property in the United States of America.

And John Locke has shown that the authority to give up one's property for the creation or support of the state is not in the people to delegate to the state. And we know that no one can delegate more authority than they hold in themselves. This is backed up by Samuel Adams, the Father of the American Revolution, in his The Rights of Colonists 1772 that "it is the greatest absurdity to suppose it in the power of one, or any number of men, at the entering into society, to renounce their essential natural rights, or the means of preserving those rights; when the grand end of civil government, from the very nature of its institution, is for the support, protection, and defense of those very rights, the principle of which, as is before, observed, are Life, Liberty and Property. If men, through fear, fraud, or mistake, should in terms renounce or give up any essential natural right, the eternal law of reason and the grand end of society would absolutely vacate such renunciation."

And this is precisely what has occurred in Texas. The people have been defrauded out of their property. It is time for the state to hear the people who are now discovering their true inheritance from the

founders and demand that the state return their property and desist from aliening it in the future. There is no issue before the Texas Congress of more import than this issue but few are responding at all and we must conclude are in fear of addressing this issue that the people have been yelling about for a number of years.

It is our right as a people to own property that cannot be aliened for the payment of taxes and if our property is not protected by this state, it is our right to form a new state that will protect our property under Art. 1 Sec. 2. We hope you all will finally do the right thing and protect the property of the people of Texas.

I hope you will refuse to support civil tyranny any longer in the State of Texas.
