Property Tax is Feudal & Alien to Texas

Purpose:

Inform Congressmen of the “State of Texas” that ad valorem property tax is the feudal system which is not lawful in any state of the Union as proven in Ron Avery’s property tax appeal to the Supreme Court by four of the major founders of America and the states thereof.

Means:

Hand out Avery’s brochures to all coming and going from the Capitol. John Schindler has printed 2,500 brochures reporting Avery’s evidence for all volunteer participants to hand out at every entry to the Capitol and the Supreme Court of Texas next door to the west of the North Plaza. Distribution Technique:


It would be impressive to have people work in groups of three; one to hold a non threatening sign, one to pass out the brochure and one to be ready to film the response to the information. The object is to spread the information not to be a freak show or scare off the representatives. You don’t have to talk. Let the brochure do the talking. Say only what you are comfortable in saying. Refer to the founders in the brochure. Let the founders do the talking!

Teams:

There appears to be four entrances to the Capitol and one or two entrances to the underground Capitol Extension to the north of the Capitol. That would mean we need 6 teams of 3 or 18 people to cover the Capitol traffic. It would be nice to cover the Supreme Court to the west of the Capitol Extension. There is at least 2 entrances there. That would be another 6 people. 24 people could cover the whole Capitol campus very well and have fun together. See red dots for entrances.

Bring:

- Water;
- Sun protection, hats etc;
- Money to park and eat;
- Cameras;
- Signs.



Parking:


The capitol has a visitor's parking garage shown in green above: Entrance is off E 12th St. or E 13th St. Exit is onto San Jacinto Blvd:

Schedule:


- 9:00 Meet at North Entry to Capitol where Avery will have the brochures to distribute to the teams.

Remember:
