This show is in preparation for opening day of the **Special Session on "Property Tax Reform."** Avery is calling for volunteers to pass out his brochures to Congressmen to inform them that we want the "State of Texas" to acknowledge that we are the true owners of the property and we don't owe property taxes and our property cannot be aliened or confiscated for failure to pay anything to the state or any other government for any purpose.



The 4th Court of Appeals (Chief Justice, **Sandee Marion**) could only assert their "**presumption of pre-existing common law**" adopted by the Texas Constitution to impose an ad valorem property tax, which was insufficient upon submission of supreme unchallenged expert testimony from four of the major founders of America (John Locke, Thomas Jefferson, John Adams and Samuel Adams) proving that such taxation is feudal tyranny and repugnant and in complete **opposition to applicable common law** in every state of the Union.



The people of the several states of the Union hold their property with a superior unalienable right, like that of royalty, **under the applicable common law, as their Saxon forefathers did in England.** (Thomas Jefferson *A Summary View of the Rights of British America* 1774) And nothing has occurred to change that.

America was populated and created for only two purposes; the establishment of **religious freedom against the canon law**, and the **prevention of property tax or the feudal law.** (John Adams *A Dissertation on the Canon and Feudal Law* 1765).

Learn why **Article 1 Section 2** of the Texas Constitution blocks the state and its subdivisions from alienating the property of the people for the payment of taxes or anything else for any purpose as shown by U.S. founder, John Locke, in his *Second Treatise of Government* (1689). The people do not have authority to take the property of their neighbor, and therefore, cannot delegate such an authority to government. Agreement to this truth is also voiced by Samuel Adams, the Father of the American Revolution. Article 1 Section 2 is not only about government being empowered by delegation from the people, but also government being limited by the authority held by individuals. Individuals do not have all authority, therefore government cannot be all powerful. **The authority to alien property of others is not in the people to delegate to government.**
